



An accessible upper level viewing platform is built into the top of the power plant and offers a commanding view westward. Wooden railings are fitted with engaging graphic panels to tell stories of the local cultural and industrial heritage.

Burgess Park with the North Bala Dam and the Muskoka Road 169 Bridge beyond

A gentle path steps visitors down to the old shore and rock face.

A gentle grassy slope brings visitors down to a rustic 'shield-like' landscape on the lower level. A protected viewing area is built to present a simple Muskoka-like look & feel at the water's edge. Area is accessible for service vehicles when required. Removeable service hatches are fitted with recycled decking.
