Re: Notice of Trespass Pursuant to the Trespass Act, 1980

Dear Save the Bala Falls Members and its guests:

It has come to our attention that the Save the Bala Falls is planning an event on provincial Crown land currently leased by Swift River Energy Limited (SREL) without permission as illustrated on the attached email.

This notice is to inform you that you and your group are not, under any circumstances, permitted access to, nor permitted to use for any public gathering or event, any of the following list of provincially owned property in Bala, Township of Muskoka Lakes, District of Muskoka, Ontario, for which Swift River Energy Limited is deemed the legal occupier under the Trespass Act 1980, through its Licence of Occupation with the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry as illustrated on the attached Schedule A survey, herein collectively referred to as the "Property":

- Part 1, locally known as Margaret Burgess Park, located west of Muskoka District Road 169, north of the North Bala Dam, and south of the Bala United Church;
- Part 3, located west of Muskoka District Road 169, east of the Moon River, south
 of the North Bala Dam, and north of the Township lands locally known as Portage
 Landing;
- Parts 4, 5 and 6, located east of Muskoka District Road 169, north of Bala Falls Road, south of Lake Muskoka, and west of Purk's Place:
- Part 7, locally known as Diver's Point or Legris Park, located east of the CP Rail tracks, north of Bala Falls Road and west of the South Bala Dam.

You are required to do the following:


Refrain from entering on the Property, promoting others to enter the Property, and placing any articles on the Property, without the express written permission of Swift River Energy Limited (the "Occupier").

If you do not comply with the above, the Ontario Provincial Police ("OPP") will be contacted and instructed to arrest you and to charge you with an offence. Swift River hereby authorizes any member of the OPP to act as Agent for the purposes of enforcing this notice.

No further warnings will be given. You are advised to conduct yourself accordingly.

Current status

- 1. As for the last ten years, the proponent still does not have all approvals needed to proceed.

Either the proponent should be required to provide environmental assessment of their <u>current</u> plans, or this confirms the environmental assessment process has been a farce all along.
